

3D Assignments for summer

Please complete all work on handout for Studio AP

1. Assemblage with found (or bought) pieces. All pieces should be the same. you may collect sticks or shells of other natural items or you may go to the dollar store and buy at least 100 of something to use as your assemblage material. Use elmers or hot glue to hold in place.

2. Model a figure / character using Knead-o air dry clay. your figure should be a person from every day life. Think about the characters that Duane Hanson created. The character should have clothing and accessories to go along with his job, personality, or other descriptive characteristics. for instance, if you model a tourist, he might have bermuda shorts, a Hawaiian shirt and a camera around his neck. Air dry clay can be formed, left to harden and then sanded. It can be painted, or you can collage with glue and paper.

While you are working with the clay it needs to be kept moist. Wrap tight in plastic. Read instructions on package. Look at the kneado website for more info.

3. Self portrait Cubist sculpture from corrugated cardboard. 12 - 18" high. Should be sculpture in the round and pleasing from all angles. Use hot glue or elmers to attach pieces. Get ideas for this from African masks or sculpture by Picasso.
