12/17-Full Day of School (Dismissal @ 2:40)

-Students will take their 1st Hour Exam beginning @ 7:50am

12/18-Half Day of School (Dismissal @ 12:00pm)

-Students will take their 3rd Hour Exam beginning @ 7:50

-Students will take their 7th Hour Exam beginning @ 10:00

12/21-Half Day of School (Dismissal @ 12:00pm)

-Students will take their 4th Hour Exam beginning @ 7:50

-Students will take their 6th Hour Exam beginning @ 10:00

12/22-Half Day of School (Dismissal @ 12:00pm)

-Students will take their 2nd Hour Exam beginning @ 7:50

-Students will take their 5th Hour Exam beginning @ 10:00

Information which may help you help your child prepare for exams

*Most teachers will give your child a review sheet to help focus their exam preparation. Ask your student if they have their review sheets completed.

*Many teachers are available before or after school next week to give your child extra assistance. Encourage your student to stay if they need help.

*Class time next week is extremely critical as teachers are preparing students for their exams. Encourage your child to be at school during this important prep-time before exams.

*The library is open next week Monday through Thursday from 3:00-4:00 so students have a quiet place to study.
