1 Binder (2 or 3 inch binder works best)

8 Poly Pocket (Plastic) dividers

Durable pencil pouch that clips into a binder

1 box of colored pencils

24 pencils (wood or mechanical)

Eraser (one large eraser or a pack of pencil top erasers)

1 highlighter

Pack of glue sticks

3 one-subject spiral notebooks (ELA & Math)

Multi-pack Post-It notes

2 Earbuds (Please buy cheap earbuds. One set of earbuds is required, but two sets are preferred. The earbuds must stay in the student's binder at all times. The extra set can stay in the student's locker.)

Stylus (Optional, but highly encouraged)

Community Supplies: **Please give to your child's homeroom teacher at Open House or the first day of school.**

Hand Sanitizer

2 boxes of Kleenex

2 boxes of pencils (pre-sharpened)

1 box of markers

Dry erase markers

Paper towels

Scotch tape (Girls Only)

Clorox Wipes (Boys Only)
