Enrolling in February allows time for schools to plan class schedules and placement of classrooms to maintain desired class size guidelines. Children need to be 5 years old by August 1, 2019, to attend kindergarten for the 2019-20 school year.



“Completing kindergarten registration in February allows our students, families and schools to be prepared for a successful school year,” said Dr. Michele Condon, superintendent of schools. “Last year, we enrolled 441 kindergarten students, one of the largest classes in the last decade. Many of
